Our Topic

We are very excited to announce our summer term topic, 'Raiders and Traders'. It will have a history focus, when we will be looking at the Vikings, their life and their invasion of Britain. The science topics are 'Classifying Critters', looking at classification of living things, and 'Staying Alive', looking at animals, including humans. We will be exploring these learning questions:

- How did the Vikings find out how to make a longboat?
- What language(s) did they speak?
- How did they prepare for war?
- Who were their rulers?
- Did they have a religion?
- What did they eat and where did they live?
- What did they wear?
- Did they have animals e.g. horses for war, pigs for food?
- Did they have any pets?
- How did they write and could many people write?

The children will also continue to practise their computing skills with Miss Riley and work on French and RE with Mr Watts.

On Friday 21st April we will have our topic **Launch Day** and we would like the children to dress in Viking outfits. During the day we will be doing fun and exciting activities to launch our topic, including mapping Viking invasion routes, creating a Viking longship and sampling a Viking feast!

After the SATs are over, we move into our preparations for the year 6 production. During this time, we also have:

- the great Year 6 Buggy Competition, where we design and make our own motorised buggies
- Theme Park maths, a maths topic where we create a business running a Theme Park
- The Apprentice, where the children work in teams to create and sell a product.

Things to Remember

Home Learning: The children will continue to have Reading Journal, maths and spelling homework each week. Occasionally, they will also be set other homework. Please continue to ensure that your child completes their homework to the best of their ability and returns it to school on the correct day:
Reading Journals are due in on Mondays
Spelling homework is due in on Tuesdays
