Bikeability is the replacement for the cycling proficiency test. The national standard is a three-level cycling training scheme. **Level 1** is a great starting point to learn/practice bike control in a traffic free environment. To be able to participate in Bikeability **Level 2** you must first complete Level 1. **Level 2 is an on-road course.** All courses will be at **Downham Leisure Centre BR1 5EP**

Short 1 hour session suitable for non riders and wobblers age 7+
