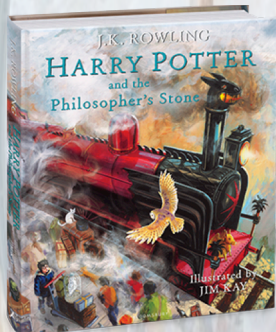

Recommended Book of the Week By Farringdon Class

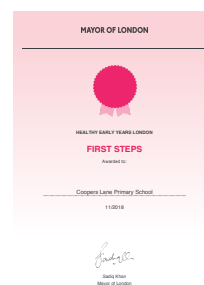
We would love to recommend this amazing edition of Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone by JK Rowling:
