THIS WEEK OUR RIGHTS OF THE WEEK ARE ARTICLES 2, 19, and 32-37

The Convention applies to children from every religion, ethnicity, gender, language, ability or family background, no matter what they think or say.

Every child has a right to be protected from all forms of violence by anyone that looks after them.

Every child has the right to be protected from financial exploitation and work that is dangerous and might harm their health, development and education.

Every child has the right to be protected from the illegal use of drugs.

Every child has the right to be protected from all exploitation.

Every child has the right to be protected from being abducted or being moved illegally for the purpose of exploitation.

Every child should be protected from the exploitation of children for political activities, by the media or for medical research.

Every child has the right to be protected from being punished in a cruel or harmful way.
