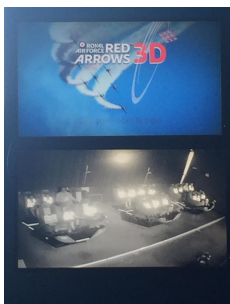
Year 3 Dojo Trip

Year 2

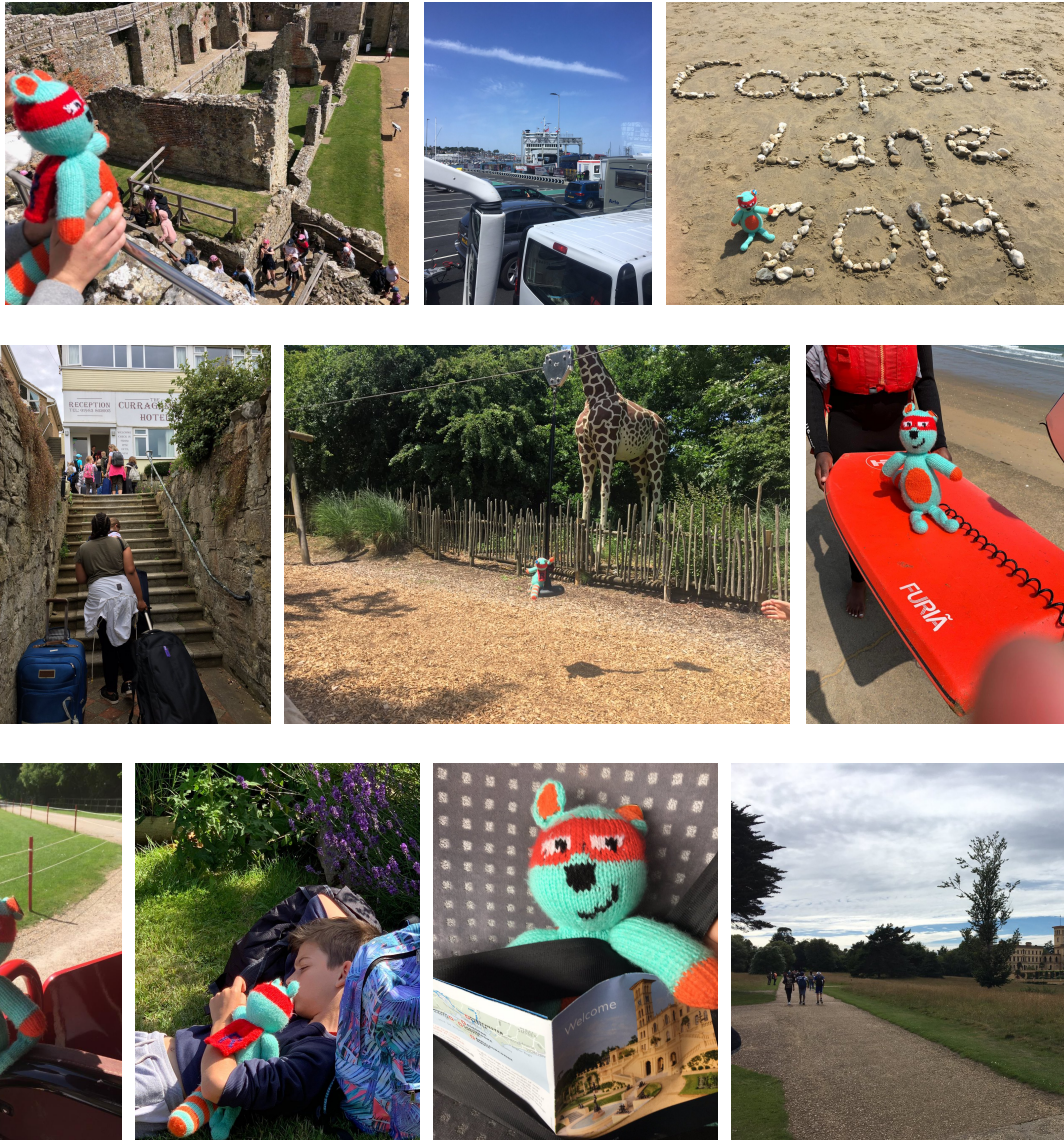
