WATER CYCLE

In Science we will be learning about the water cycle. We will focus on identifying the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.

Your topic homework is to draw a comic strip showing the life of a water droplet as it journeys through the water cycle.

You must include the following vocabulary terms:

- evaporation
- condensation
- precipitation
- water vapour
- water cycle
