So, what is a young carer?



A young carer is someone who has to look after parents or siblings who struggle to care for themselves because of illness.

Many people don't realise the important and hard role young carers have, helping a parent or relative every day.

This can sometimes affect their normal life and the extra responsibilities being a carer brings.

Tens of thousands of children in the UK care for an adult in their life.

The 2011 census identified 166,363 young carers in England.

1 in 8 was under the age of 8.
