#### Welcome

Hello and welcome to all of our new Year 5 children and parents. We are very excited for next year and are looking forward to working with you all.

We kick-start Year 5 with our Autumn term topic called **Fabulous Pharaohs** where we will be exploring the world of Ancient Egypt.

### **Our Topic**

Over the course of the Autumn term, we will explore these exciting learning questions:

- Can I place Ancient Egypt on a timeline?
- Where in the world is Egypt?
- Can I describe the features of the landscape?
- What is written on the walls of Tut's Tomb?
- What is mummification?
- What is the belief behind the After Life?
- Why so many gods?
- What was the social order of things?
- Hieroglyphs what does it all mean?
- Designing a death mask
- Everyday life what was it like?
- Modern day Egypt?

**In English**, we will be writing stories, poems, and descriptive settings, letters and non-chronological reports. We will also be using drama to explore themes.

**In Maths**, we will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, measures (area and perimeter), geometry (shapes) and fractions.

**In Science**, we will learn all about materials, by identifying their purposes, features and uses. We will also compare and group materials and will investigate how some materials dissolve in liquids to make solutions.
