### Welcome

We will kick-start 2020 with our Spring term topic called **Home Is Where the Heart Is** where we will be exploring the theme of home and the landscape of our famous city, London. Have a very merry Christmas and a happy New Year! Miss Walker, Miss Maynard, Miss Bentley and the team.

# **Our Topic**

Over the course of the Spring term, we will explore these exciting learning questions:

- What does 'home' mean?
- · Why is London our Capital City?
- Why do people live in London?
- How has the population of London grown over the past 100 years?
- What are the main advantages and disadvantages to living in London?
- What are the main advantages and disadvantages to living in a village?
- How has our environment changed to pose a danger on living things?

**In English**, we will be writing to entertain our readers through character descriptions, setting descriptions and narrative. We will be using drama throughout the term to support our writing.

**In Maths**, we will be focusing on multiplication and division and their related facts. We will also learn how to calculate area, then spend some time working with fractions. We will be regularly applying our problem solving and reasoning skills too.

**In Science**, we will be exploring Living things and their Habitats - identifying and classifying plants, vertebrates and invertebrates. After half term we will be learning about electricity and which materials make good conductors or insulators.
