### **Our Topic**

Over the course of the Spring term, we will be exploring these exciting learning questions:

- How does the movement of the Earth affect us?
- Why do we have different time zones?
- What are the moon phases?
- What is the history of Space Travel?
- What could space sound like?
- How do the forces of gravity, air resistance and upthrust work?
- How can you use forces to save a Space Egg?
- How can we use pulleys. levers and gears to help us in everyday life?

In English, we will be learning to write persuasively in the first half term and will be reading the book Stormbreaker. We will also be watching film clips about the imaginary planet of Pandora to help inspire us. In the second half term, we will then be writing to inform and will be focusing on Space.

**In Maths**, we will be learning about multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and percentages.

This term we will also be having 'Music Fridays' where for the first 20 minutes of the day we will be exploring the work of a range of different composers.
