## **RE: Children of Key Workers, Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6**

Thank you to all those parents who have responded to my letter sent on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May. We can now give you further information regarding the re-opening of school for more pupils in the named year groups.

As communicated previously, school will be closed for staff training on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June. There will be no breakfast/tea club provision at the current time; however, we are doing our best to find solutions to this.

Please note that the school opening to more pupils is still subject to the Government being satisfied that their key safety tests have been met. This will be decided on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May.

### **Children of Key Workers and Vulnerable Groups**

If you have requested a place, your child will be able to start school on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June. You will receive a letter tomorrow detailing the information that you will need, including drop off/pick up times and the allocated classroom for your child. If you do not receive a letter it is because we have not received any communication from you, and your child will not be able to start on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.

### **Nursery and Reception**

At the current time, we are only opening for the children of Key Workers and Vulnerable Groups. See above.

### **Year 1 and Year 6**

If you have requested a place via Parent Pay, your child will be able to start school on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June. You will receive a letter at the beginning of next week detailing the information that you will need, including drop off/pick up times and the allocated classroom for your child.

If you have not yet used Parent Pay to let us know that you need a school place for your child, **you must do this by 9am on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May**, in order for them to start on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June.

We do understand that your thoughts on your child returning to school may change. Therefore, we will be offering you regular opportunities to update your decision, ensuring that we have enough notice to plan for increasing numbers of children. I'm sure that you understand how important this is so that we can safeguard our children and adults effectively.
