Important reminders

Drop off and Collection



Thank you for following the new procedures and having patience. Drop off and collection is now running very smoothly, with most people

following the guidance, which is so important in order to keep us all safe. Please remember:

- Arrive at the correct time.
- Be patient when queuing outside to come in.
- Do not jump the queue.
- Do not stop to talk to other parents or school staff either outside the school or on the route around the playground.
- Keep one family behind the other at all times with a 2m gap between you.
- Follow the one-way system at all times. This is clearly marked in yellow so should be easy to follow. Please do not cross the playground even if this is a quicker pathway.
- Do not allow your children to play on the equipment at drop off or pick-up. They must stay with you at all times.
- Only I adult with each family please.

Please remember that the children all need a water bottle to use in class. We have fresh water taps in every class so the children are able to refill their bottles throughout the day.

This week we have been studying 'The Journey' by Francesca Saana and considering what life would be like for a refugee who had to leave their home.


We created our own collages after looking closely at the illustrations from the story.
