RE

Children will explore the Sikhism religion and their beliefs. They'll find out about their beliefs about God, and the ten human Gurus. They will understand more about the Guru Nanak and his birthday celebration.

PSHE

Children will consolidate what they know about being a good friend. They'll learn how friendships support wellbeing and the importance of finding support if they feel lonely or excluded. They will look at how friendships sometimes have difficulties and how to overcome this.

Science
