






# **Year Three Settlements & Populations**

## Glossary

**Conurbation**- an urban area made up of a number of cities, towns and villages to merge one built up area

Facilities - places where certain things happen for a purpose. Such as schools for education, parks for playing or shops for selling things.

**Hamlet** - a very small human settlement

**Physical features** - a feature on the Earth's surface that has been formed by nature

**Population** - the total number of people living in a country, city, or area VEGETATION

Residence - a person's home

**Rural** - an open country area that is located outside towns and cities

**Settlements** - a place where people live, such as a single house or a large city

**Urban** - a built-up area with a large population such as a city or town

A rural area is **sparsely** populated (not many people living there) and is described as being in "the country" (away from towns and cities.



An urban area is densely populated (has lots of people living there) and is described as a town or a city.


