
















Converting length










You might measure the length of a road or the distance between two cities in miles or kilometres.

## Things that could be measured using imperial units:

- · Someone's height in feet and inches
- The mass of a bag of sugar in ounces
- The mass of a sack of potatoes in pounds
- · A person's mass in stones
- A carton of milk in pints
- The amount of water in a bath in gallons
- 1 foot = 12 inches
- 1 pound = 16 ounces
- 1 stone = 14 pounds
- 1 gallon = 8 pints
