Climate - the weather conditions over a long period of time

Population - the total number of people living in a country, city, or area

Greece is in the **continent** of Europe. Greek land includes 6,000 islands but only 227 **islands** are **inhabited**.



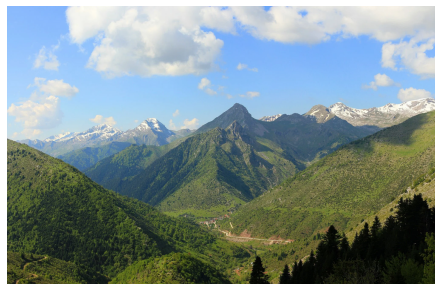
There are **3 seas** surrounding Greece. The Aegean Sea, Mediterranean Sea, and the Ionian Sea.
