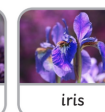

## Glossary

**Deciduous** - a tree that loses its leaves each year

**Evergreen** - a tree that keeps its leaves all year round, even in winter

**Garden plant** - plants that people choose to grow in their gardens

**Weeds** - wild plants that grow in places that people don't want them

**Wild plants** - a plant that grows wherever the seed has fallen. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows
