Children will learn about the birth of the British Empire looking at trade routes to Asia and North America. They will also look at The Atlantic Slave Trade to understand why it happened, what life was like for a slave and how slavery was abolished in Britain.

Talk about what career you might like to have. Does anyone in your family inspire you? How will you achieve it?

RE

Children will learn about the importance of pilgrimage in the Islamic faith. They will look at the difference between Hajj and Umrah, and the expectation that all Muslims undertake the pilgrimage to Mecca once in their lives. Children will learn the story of the Prophet Ibrahim (pbuh) and his son Ismail (pbuh) who rebuilt Ka'aba.



PSHE

Children will be thinking about career aspirations and what they would like to do when they are older. They will look at a range of professions and learn about what training you would need to get into them. They'll discuss that people often have more than one type of job over their lifetime and the difference between a job and a career.

Science

Children will learn about the differences in the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. They'll look at the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals, including sexual and asexual reproduction. They'll also learn about the work of naturalists Sir David Attenborough and Jane Goodall.

Computing

Children will become architects! They will learn how to use simple CAD software to create a 3d design, explore a virtual environment and develop a greater aesthetic awareness.
