Some maps show us huge areas like a map of the world, and others show us smaller places, like a map of Grove Park or our school.



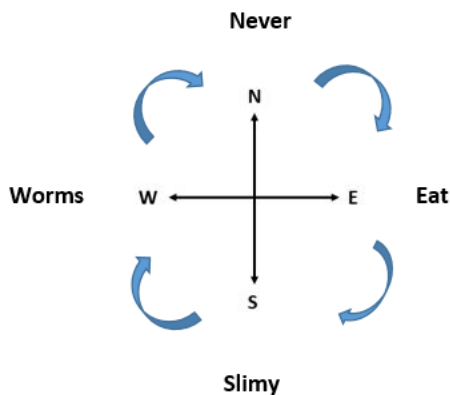
Map makers are called **CARTOGRAPHERS**.

Aerial - something that happens from above

Compass - an instrument which shows the direction of North, East, South and West
