RE

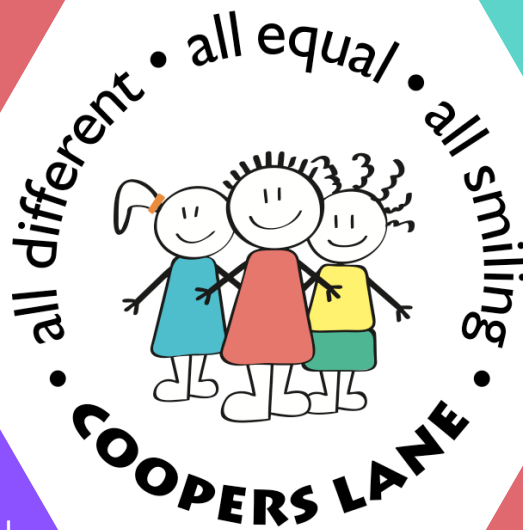
Children are introduced to the

Geography

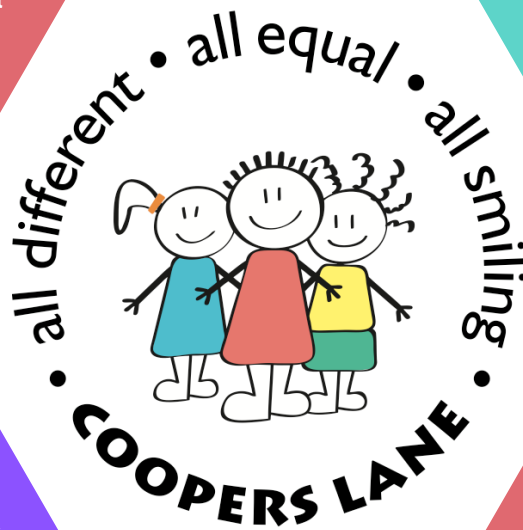
Children will begin to explore the wider world. Looking at the difference between sea and land, continents and what they're like. They will also look at hot and cold places across the world.
