RE

PSHE

Children will develop friendship skills recognising what they feel when they are lonely and what can be done about it. They will learn to use restorative chats to resolve disagreements.

Computing

Children will become astronauts as they program a sprite to move around the screen.

Science

PE

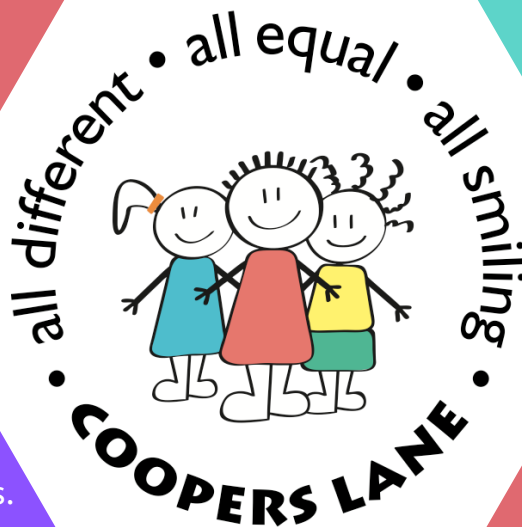

- Islam

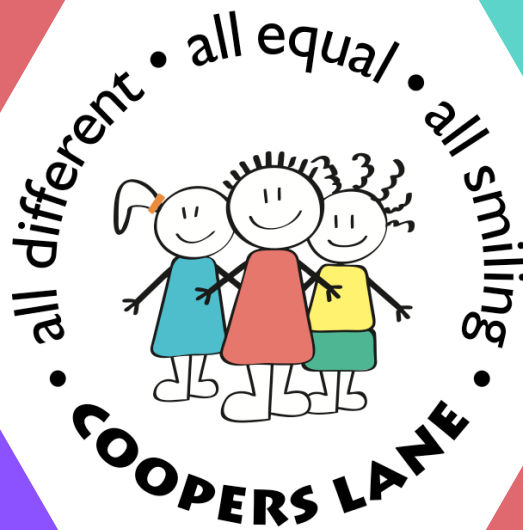
RE
