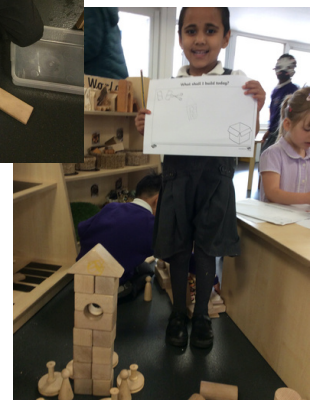
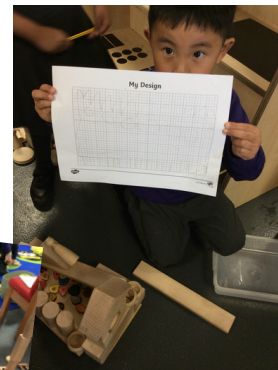
## NURSERY

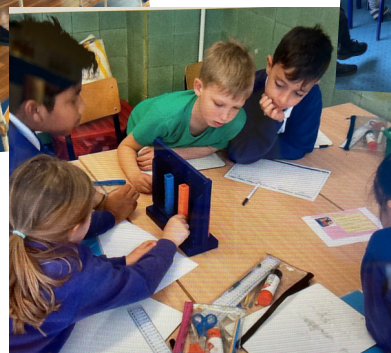
## RECEPTION

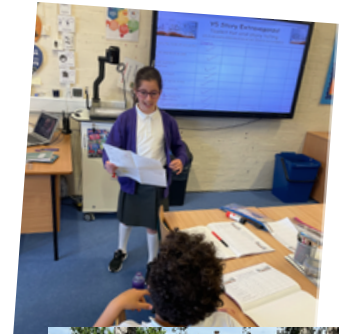
## YEAR 4
