#### NURSERY

#### RECEPTION

This week in Reception the children have started their Floppys Phonics lessons. We have looked at 's' and 'a.' They have persevered with their letter formation. Some children also decorated their own Elmer the Elephants.







Year 1 have been learning all about our oceans, and thinking about what we can do to help keep them clean, after reading 'Odd Fish'. We have made our own fish using plastic bottles and other recyclable materials, so that less plastic ends up in the ocean, and in provision, we worked collaboratively to make a giant net to clean up the rubbish in the ocean!
