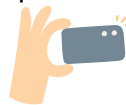

NURSERY

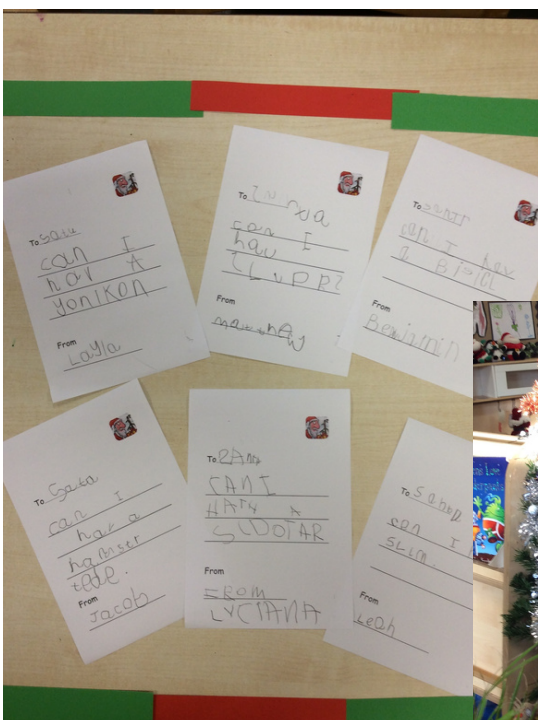

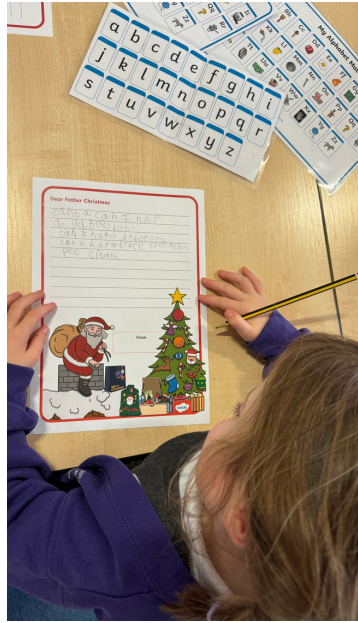
RECEPTION
