English and Maths

In English we will continue to enjoy Drawing Club! We will continue to read a variety of picture books, some linked to our mini topics, and look at their characters, settings and then we will go on an adventure out of the stories using our imagination. We are continuing to focus on sentence structure and using our Phonics to help spell unknown words, but we'll also be trying to write more!

In Maths we will build on our Autumn learning, but extend up to 20 then 50 within place value, continue to practice addition and subtraction, and have fun with length, height, volume and mass.

Things to remember

Reading: Please ensure book bags are brought to school daily, as books will be changed when children read with a class adult. One new book will be issued for the week to develop fluency and increase comprehension. We really appreciate help, from an adult or older sibling at home, listening, reading and sharing books with your children daily. All children will visit the Library each **Thursday** morning. They will bring one book home to be returned the following week, unless they haven't finished it. **Homework**: In Year I, there will be weekly homework. This will be spellings and maths. Spellings will be based on sounds and tricky words they learn each week. They will be also continue to use their Numbots log in to practise maths each day for 5 minutes.

Forest School: London Bridge will enjoy Forest School in Spring I, and Tower Hill will visit in the Spring 2. This is on a **Thursday**. Children must leave a pair of wellies at school for the half term, and wear clothes appropriate for the weather and climbing trees. Long sleeves and trousers should be worn. **PE:** All children will continue to participate in PE with Coach Nick on a **Friday** morning. Please wear outdoor PE kits - dark joggers, coloured t-shirt, trainers and their school jumper.
